

Home Learning Frequently Asked Questions

Can you make your worksheets interactive and compatible with different systems?

When we first released our premium resources we never designed for them to be an online worksheet, they were very much a paper-based resource. We couldn't have predicted where we've ended up less than 2 years later. Whilst we would love to make them interactive, it really is a huge job that we just don't have the capacity for at the moment.

In the last lockdown we received numerous requests for printed versions so that children could send in pictures of their completed work which is why we produced printed workbooks.

What are the recap lessons?

The recap lessons are steps taken from the previous year group's content. These were added in where we felt children may need extra time to master a concept due to it being particularly challenging or perhaps missing some content during the previous lockdown. The resources for these steps are exact replicas of the resources in the prior year group.

What are activity lessons?

These were also added where we felt children may require extra time and practise to consolidate learning. These videos do not have a worksheet as the activities are embedded within the videos on slides with a purple border.

Where are the videos hosted and how can they be downloaded?

All videos can be viewed on our [home learning page](#). Our videos are also hosted on Vimeo. We use Vimeo to host our online training videos, so it seemed logical to stick with that platform. We are aware that some schools block Vimeo and we are exploring alternative platforms for hosting them. We've made sure that the home learning videos can be downloaded so that schools can share them centrally on their drive if they want to, and we provide direct links to videos if schools would rather whitelist them that way. Direct hyperlinks are also being added to the lesson by lesson progression to hopefully ease the process of finding the relevant content.

Can we miss out a block of learning in order to save it for when face to face teaching resumes?

The home learning resources are being produced in line with the lesson by lesson progression that follows our schemes of learning. Therefore, if you choose to teach topics in a different order there is no guarantee that we will have released home learning resources to match the content you are replacing it with. Within our schemes of learning we also interleave content meaning that our resources may include skills being recapped that you may not have taught if you do not follow the same progression.

Some of the videos are not available if I follow the mixed age progression. When will they be released?

As the videos and teaching slides are new for this academic year, we are creating and releasing them following our updated single age lesson by lesson progressions and releasing them on our premium site as soon as they are available. Our team are working as hard as possible to get further ahead with the production of the videos. Unfortunately, if you are a mixed age teacher you may find that some of the videos and teaching slides won't be there in time this academic year. Whilst we would love to release them quicker we're just not willing to compromise on quality. We have made this as clear as possible and it's highlighted in the guidance page on all of our lesson by lesson overviews as we wanted to be upfront about it from the start. You might find it useful to look at our [archived videos](#) from last summer which you can access from the home learning page and see if any of those can help you at those times.

Do you have to subscribe to get access to the worksheets and videos?

The videos on the premium site are the same as the ones on our home learning page and will remain completely free. The worksheets however are part of the premium subscription. As an alternative to getting a premium subscription you could purchase [workbooks](#) as these are just a collated, printed version of the worksheets.

How much is access to the premium resources?

The cost of a school subscription starts at £120 for a full year and gives access to a worksheet for every small step in our scheme of learning, available in three different formats: write on, display and PowerPoint. You will also have access to our Flashback Four and True or False revision resources. New this year, you will also be able to access the teaching slides that are created by our specialists and used in our home learning videos. I already have a subscription; will this automatically renew?

Your subscription won't automatically renew but you will be sent an email reminding you to renew your subscription. You can also renew your subscription in the 'My Account' area.

How can I buy the workbooks?

Workbooks can be purchased as school bundles or as individual packs. A half class set contains 15 workbooks. These can be purchased in topic sets or as whole term bundles. Do you have videos for Year 10 and 11?

As we produced the videos for Year 10 and 11 for Oak National Academy we are yet to produce videos for these year groups in the same format as our other home learning videos. However, this is something that we will be doing in the future.

Are there premium resources and videos for EYFS?

Our Premium Resources are currently in the form of worksheets which we don't feel is appropriate for Reception age children. This means that we currently do not have anything on our Premium website for Reception. However, the home learning videos for reception remain completely free of charge on the [home learning section](#) of our website. We are currently working hard trying to come up with ideas of what is best to offer for Reception in terms of Premium Resources, and as soon as we know more we will announce it. What is the summer archive?

The [summer archive](#) is the set of videos we created that followed a specially designed 12-week plan during the first lockdown in Summer 2020. All of these videos in here do match small steps within our schemes of learning however they may not be in the same order that would be found in our schemes as key learning was prioritised. These videos are not in the exact same format as our newer home learning videos and therefore all of these lessons will be re-done this year to match all the other new content. However, if you teach mixed age or are choosing to teach topics in a different order then there may be some videos here that can help.

Why are there repeated questions on the second page of the worksheets?

The questions are duplicated on the display version for when children are sharing but may be working at a different pace. This means that the sheet can be turned over if students are working at a different pace. This only happens on the display worksheet, if you use the write on worksheet the questions are not duplicated.
