2	<p>a) </p> <p>b) </p> <p>c)  or </p>
3	<p>a) The pentagon has turned a half turn.</p> <p>b) The hexagon has turned a quarter turn. or The hexagon has turned a three-quarter turn.</p> <p>Part b) has two possible answers, depending which direction the shape turns.</p>
4	<p>Both are correct. The turn can be described as either a quarter or three-quarters, depending on the direction of turn.</p>
